- Proof of Lane County residency
- Proof that the child lives with you
- Proof of child's age

It is strongly suggested not to bring children to pick up. **Please bring required documents on Distribution Day**

Example of Required Documents

- For Parents/Guardians:
 - Local Photo ID with address (this provides proof of residency in Lane County)
- For Children: Any number
 - Birth Certificate
 - Recent School Report Cards
 - IRS Tax Forms
 - Medical Documents Showing Both Parents and child's names
 - DHS Paperwork if it includes a child's age
 - Renter's agreement
 - Any other legal documentation that includes both the parent's and child's name(s) and date of birth(s)
