We are incredibly excited to inform you that South Lane School District 45J will implement a new option available to schools participating in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs called the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) for the next four school years 2022-2026.

**What does this mean for you and your student(s)?**

All enrolled students at all South Lane SD schools are eligible to receive a healthy breakfast and lunch at school at **no charge!**

This program is determined based on data provided through multiple avenues ***not including*** family meal applications for free and reduced meals. In order for our district data to be correct and ***to continue to receive benefit funding, we ask that every family still complete a meal program application*** for data and statistical record keeping. All applications are convenient and confidential, only viewed by the District Office Food Service Staff and filed for reporting purposes only.
