# **Staggered Start Schedule for Grades 1-5**

At the beginning of the school year half of the students attend on Wednesday, September 6th and the other half will attend on Thursday, September 7th. **Both September 6th and 7th will be "Early Release" days at 12:30 pm.** All students in grades 1-5 will come to school on Friday, September 8th release at 2:30.

Last names A-K start Wednesday, September 6th & Last names L-Z start Thursday, September 7th

If your student attends school in one of our programs such as the Owls Nest, Hawks Nest, Preschool Promise or Eagles Nest (Lane ESD Lifeskill), they may have an alternate schedule and their teacher will contact you. There is no supervision for students prior to 7:45 am. Breakfast in our cafeteria is available to students from 7:45-8:05 am.

# Kindergarten Staggered Start Schedule

During the week of September 6th - 8th, families will schedule a one-on-one family visit directly with one of our teachers and attend the Family Classroom Visit on Friday, **September 8th** at 10:30 - 11:30 am. Kinders will start school on **Monday, September 11th** and attend school on a shortened schedule through September 29th with a daily schedule from 8:10 am - 12:30 pm. On **Monday, October 2nd** they'll join our regular school hours for the rest of the year.

### Go Home Plan - How will your child get home from school?

A **Go Home Plan** form is enclosed with this letter. **Your child's Go Home Plan is essential!** It details how your student is getting home and the authorized adults who can pick them up. You can bring this to our Back to School BBQ event on September 5th or on the first day of school.

### **Supply Fee**

Please plan to provide your \$25 school supply fee to your student's classroom teacher or the front office during the first week of school. \$20 of that supply fee will be used for specific supplies in the classroom, while \$5 of that fee will be used for field trips. You can deliver this to your child's teacher or our front office. Thank you!

### **Attendance**


School attendance is the strongest predictor of academic success. Because of the importance of regular attendance, there are stringent state guidelines requiring all students to attend school regularly and on time. Did you know?

- Starting in preschool and kindergarten, too many absences can cause children to fall behind in school.
- Missing 10%, or about 2 days each month over the course of a school year, can make it harder to learn to read.
- Students can still fall behind if they miss just 1 or 2 days every few weeks.

### **Arrival**

**Solid Start at 8:15:** This school year South Lane is implementing a strong and consistent start at 8:15 am across all elementary schools. Students not in their classrooms by 8:15 am will be considered tardy (unless related to SLSD transportation delays). Please help your child feel prepared by arriving by at least 8:05 am.

**Busses & Vehicle Drop-off for Grades 1st-5th:** Please drop your student off at the farthest gym entry, which opens at 7:45. Please remember to stay in your car and continue to pull forward around the peninsula during drop off. Front doors open at 8:05, if you wish to walk your child to class. Please park and use the crosswalk. For safety reasons we do not allow families to enter with students through the gym entry or attend morning choices with them.

**Morning Choices for Grades 1st-5th**: We serve breakfast in the cafeteria from 7:45-8:05. At 7:55 we open other options (some are weather dependent). Students can choose from the library, playground, board games/socializing in a section of the cafeteria. Students are only allowed to move from breakfast to one choice and must stay in their selected choice until the 8:05 bell. We'd love students to join earlier and eat in our cafeteria but we will also offer a grab and go breakfast for students arriving closer to our start time of 8:15.

**Kinder & Special Programs Drop-off:** These students will be dropped off at the "pool parking lot" at the back of the school. Staff will be ready to meet students at 8:00. Breakfast will be served for Kinder in the classroom as students arrive. For safety, please attend to the cones and signs indicating where to pull forward as buses for our special programs also drop off and pick up in this parking lot. The bus loading area, which includes the entire curb, must be kept clear at all times during the school day. There is no loading and unloading at the curb. Please park and walk your child to the gate. The kinder gate closes at 8:10, after that time please bring your child to the front of the school.

### **Dismissal**

**Parking or walking to pick up Grades 1st-5th:** Please meet your student by the rocks or stand on the island across from the crosswalk. A teacher will make eye contact & send them to you.

Driving to pick up Grades 1st-5th: Please arrive AT or AFTER 2:30 (12:30 on Wednesdays). Our teachers won't be out before this time. We'll stay outside until 2:45 (12:45 on Wednesdays) to meet families. Pull forward when cars are moving. When an adult walks up to your vehicle, please tell the adult the grade and name of your student and we will use radios to assist getting them quickly. If needed park on the street or circle the block when waiting for the pick-up line to move as we cannot block traffic on Taylor. Police & emergency services are expecting this.

**Kinder, Preschool & Special Programs Drop-off:** These students will be picked up at the "pool parking lot" at the back of the school. Older siblings will join their kinder Bobcats & come out this way as well.
